

***Ophiogomphus incurvatus incurvatus* Carle**

Appalachian Snaketail

23 May - 6 Jul

Uncommo

40-49 mm (1.6-2.0 in.)

Small

MALE: Eyes: green. Face: green. Thorax: bright green w/ light brown middorsal stripe/lateral stripes. Abdomen: slender, black w/ line of middorsal tan/yellow triangles (S2-8); S8-10 swollen; S9-10 tan/yellow. Legs: brown. Stigmas: dark. Appendages: tan/yellow.

Habitat: Sunlit rapids.

Reproduction: Exuviae on side of rocks in stream, tree roots 1' up. Emergence 9:15-10:30 a.m.

Notes: Old name: Allegheny Snaketail. Was *O. carolinus*.

Locations: Fall Line, Kindler - D, Little Patuxent River near Savage, Middle Patuxent River at Cedar Lane, Font Hill, Savage Mill, Vantage Point - LPR/S, Vollmerhausen - IB, Wincopin, Woodstock.
