

***Tramea onusta* Hagen**

**Red Saddlebags**

**20 Oct [one record]**

**STRAY**

**41-49 mm (1.6-2.0 in.)**

**Medium**

**MALE:** Face: pale orange to red. Thorax: brown. Abdomen: red (lighter than *T. carolina*); S8-9 black on dorsal half, S10 narrowly black. Legs: pale brown to knees, then blackish. HWs: dark reddish-brown band w/ red veins criss-crossing reaches to middle of anal loop/has basal clear spot. Stigmas: tawny/brown. Appendages: yellowish-red w/ blackish tips.

**FEMALE:** Similar to male but HW band smaller than on male.

**Notes:** Old name: Red-mantled Saddlebags, Red-mantled Glider.

**Similar species:** *T. carolina* (Carolina S.) has more extensive black on abdomen.
